



## Important Correction Notice

### ***Compounding Sterile Preparations, 4<sup>th</sup> Edition (P4849)*** **by E. Clyde Buchanan, Philip J. Schneider, and Ryan A. Forrey**

The publisher wishes to inform you of an important correction.

On page 221 in Chapter 14: Storage and Beyond-Use Dating, replace the third paragraph with the following (deletions are red-lined, and additions are in bold):

The USP Chapter <797> category of immediate-use CSPs applies only to emergencies or an immediate patient care need requiring administration of an otherwise low-risk CSP ~~(less than three ingredients)~~; the medication is compounded using a continuous process, with aseptic technique, but without the primary engineering controls for low-risk CSPs. Immediate-use CSPs have a BUD of up to 1 hour, after which, if administration does not commence, the CSP should be safely discarded following standard operating procedures of the organization.<sup>3</sup> **(See Chapter 3.)**
